## Art After Dark – This Thursday, September 24 Successful Gallery Tour Turns One!

Last fall marked the first Art After Dark, an event designed to showcase 11 amazing downtown art galleries as well as local and international artists' works. Each gallery offered light refreshments, great conversation and of course, compelling art. Kingstonians flocked to the event. Art After Dark grew with a show in the Spring and this Thursday it will boast the participation of 14 galleries.

The event's time has been changed slightly in the interest of truly being "after dark". It will now run from 7pm-10pm

Modern Fuel will be taking advantage of the event to present a video screening in the Courtyard of Springer Market Square. The screening will show films produced this past summer as part of the *Voice Off* program. *Voice Off* was a multi-media based project that brought artists Sarah DeCarlo and Bear Thomas together with youth ages 12-25 at the Katarokwi Native Friendship Centre. The program allowed for the youth to gain media skills facilitated an opportunity to explore, create and share personal and community experiences and stories through new media and video technologies.
