Snowbirds set to Grace the Skies over Kingston for RMC Graduation!

Thursday, May 19th at 6pm The Canadian Forces Air Demonstration Team, best known at **The Snowbirds**, will grace the skies over Downtown Kingston! as they perform in celebration of this year's graduating class at RMC. A fly-past over the RMC grounds will be followed by a 15 minute flat show from 6:15 – 6:30. If you miss this presentation, The Snowbirds will say goodbye to Kingston with a **noon hour** fly by the next day, **Friday May 20th**.

The Snowbirds are made up of nine Canadian Forces pilots who will perform in their CT-114 jets. The Snowbirds have been performing for over forty years and have entertained over 8 million people, both young and old, in more than 1500 air shows, including the opening ceremonies for the Olympic Games held in Montreal and Calgary. Kingstonians will have a chance to catch this unbelievable show from Confederation Basin as they perform over the Cataraqui River.

In this, their 41st season, the Canadian Forces Snowbirds will hold approximately 55 performances in 31 locations across Canada and the United States, representing the skill, professionalism, and teamwork of the Canadian Forces and inspiring Canadians to consider a career in Canada's military.
