Downtown Kingston’s beautiful Springer Market Square will once again be transformed into an outdoor movie theatre for most Thursday nights this summer. An eclectic line-up of classic movies will be projected on a 24 x 40 foot inflatable screen parallel to Market Street in the Square. Movies will begin at dusk, about 9:00 pm for the June and July showings and closer to 8:30 pm for the features in August. All movies are free!
