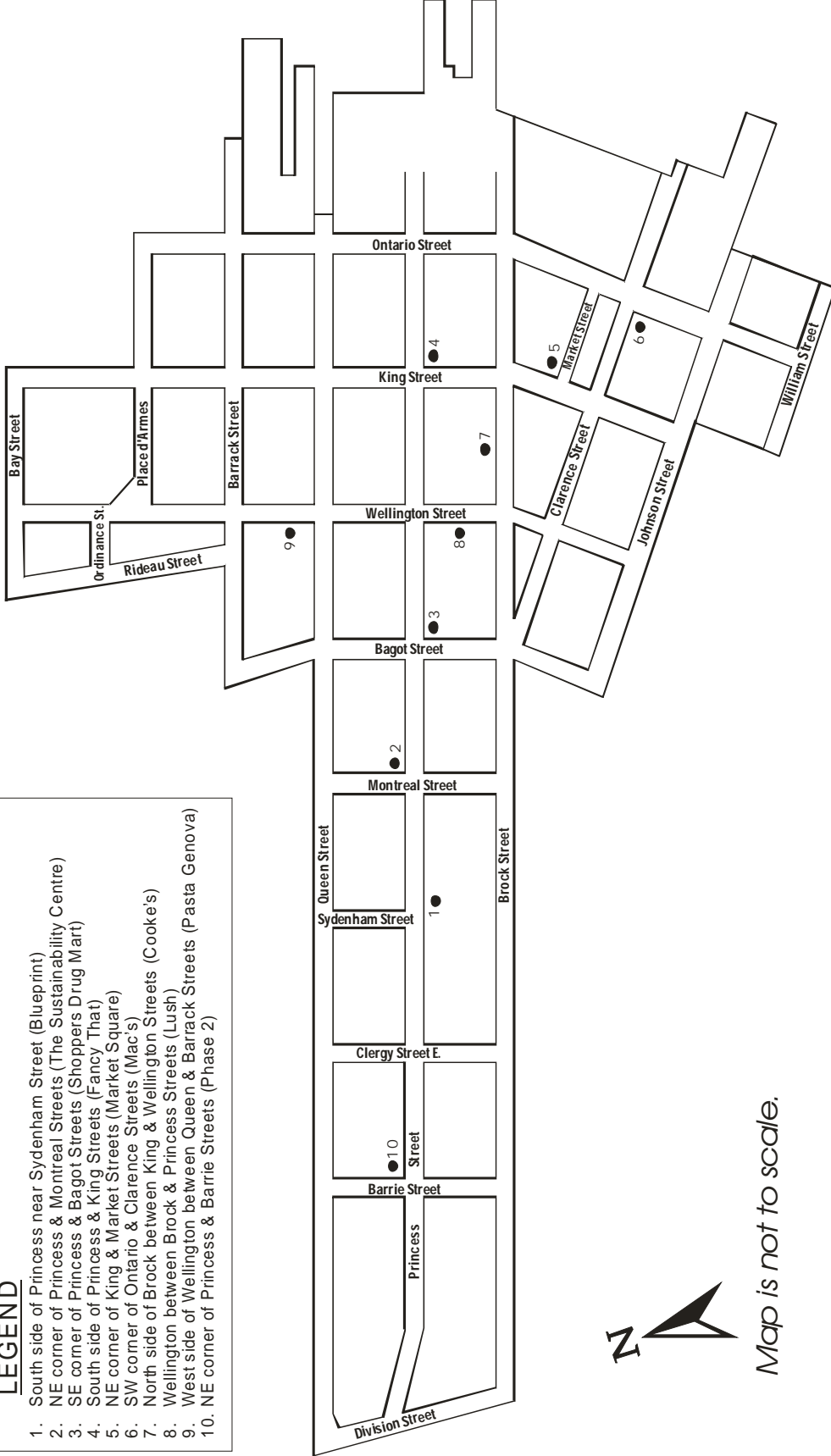

9. West side of Wellington between Queen & Barrack Streets (**Pasta Genova**)
10. NE corner of Princess & Barrie Streets (**Phase 2**)

NOTES:

Pedestrian traffic was recorded at 10 locations over a **2 week period** during the last week of July and the first week of August.

The information presented is a "**Weekly (7 Day) Average**" of total pedestrian traffic per hour, **between the hours as indicated**.

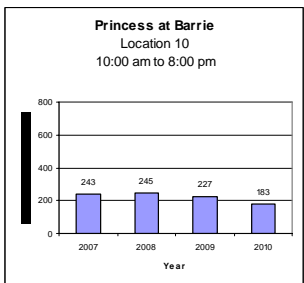
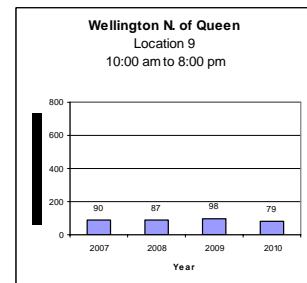
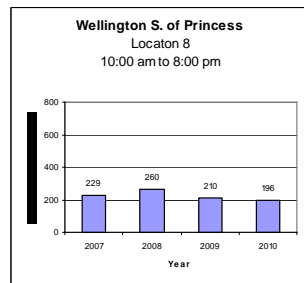
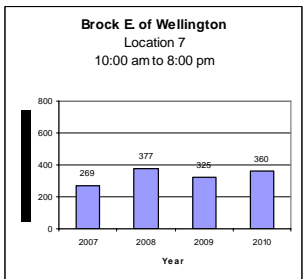
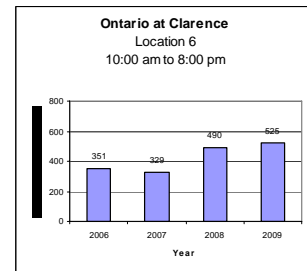
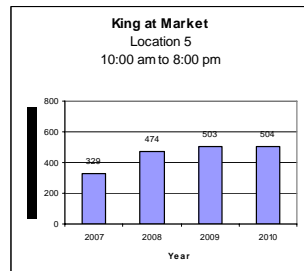
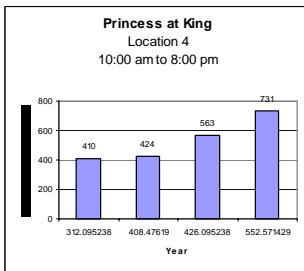
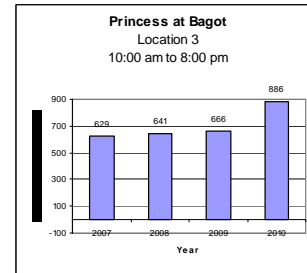
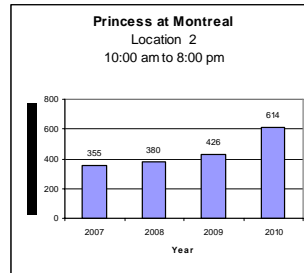
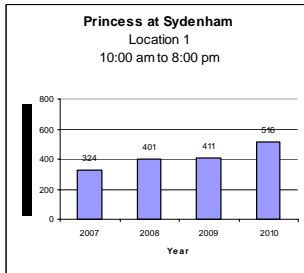
RESULTS:

On average, the **highest pedestrian counts** during the day were recorded at Princess & Bagot Streets, and have remained the highest over the past 4 years, while the **lowest counts** were recorded at Wellington Street between Queen & Barrack Streets.

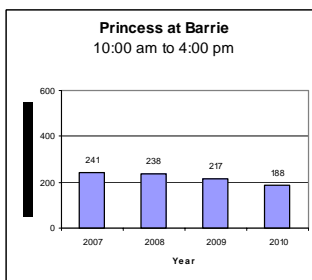
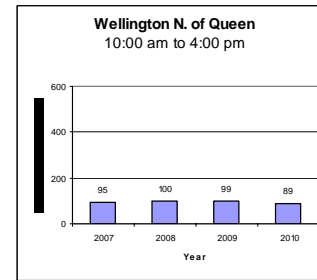
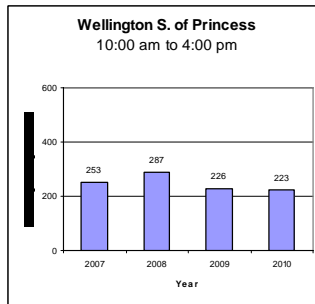
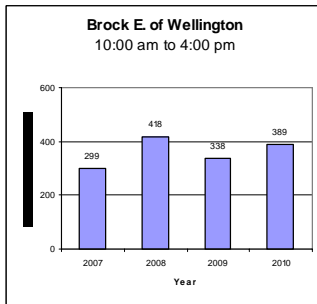
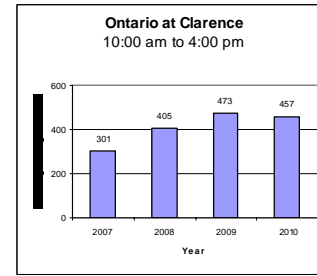
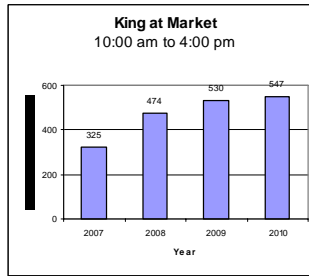
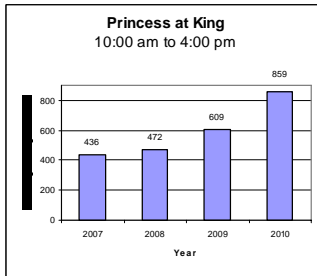
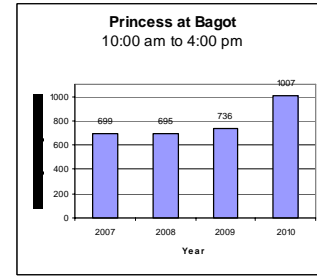
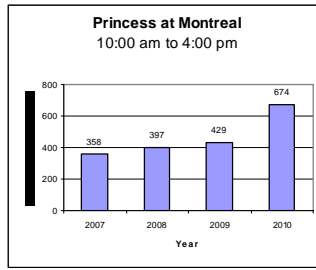
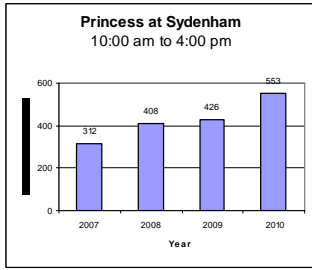
Public Market days occur on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays, with an Antique Market occurring on Sundays throughout the survey in Market Square.

In 2010, a sidewalk sale was held July 30 to August 2 with the Princess Street Promenade being held on that Saturday. The 1000 Islands Poker Run was held August 6 to 8 and the K-town Tri was August 1.

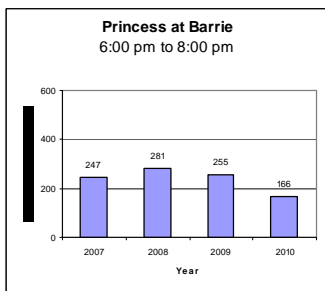
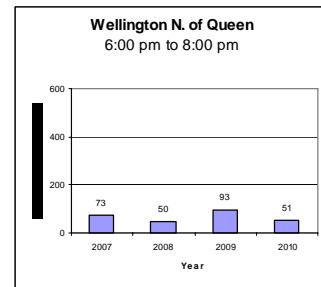
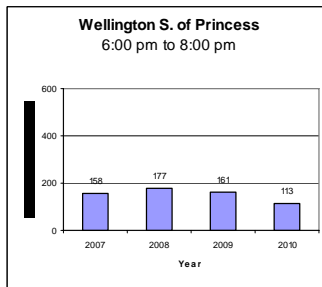
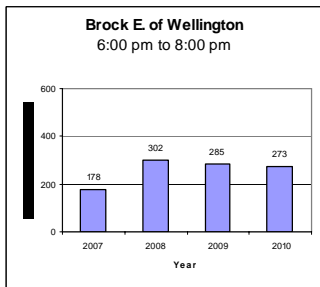
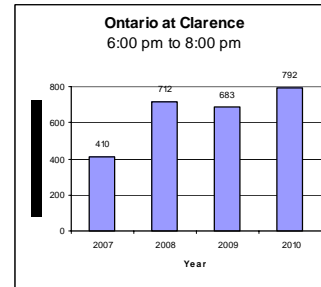
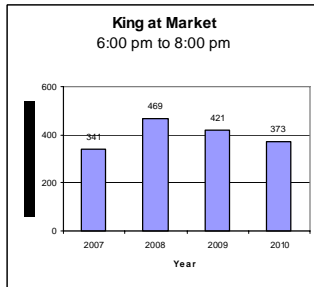
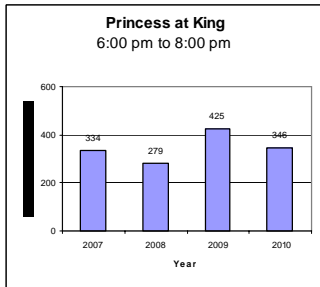
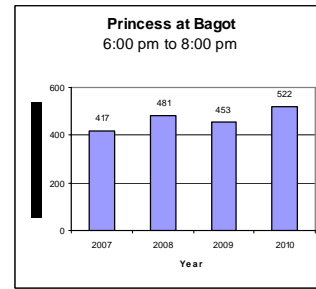
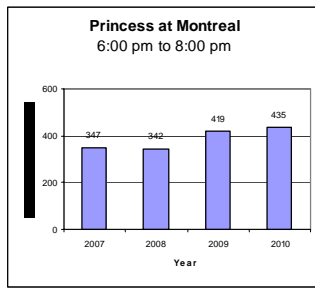
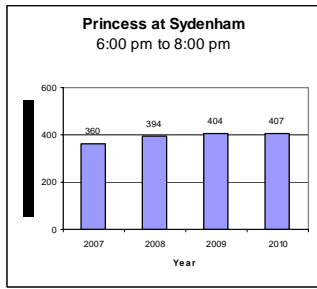
Average Number of People Per Hour – 10:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
